Fence height is 1.8mtr – ground Could jump over or dig under	It is for customer to ascertain if their dog is likely to jump over or dig under	If so – do not attend
Entry / Exit via 2 points Could easily exit	Client to ensure gates are secure following entry before unleashing dogs	Read all instructions
Holding area Possibility of interaction between bookings	Clients are asked to ensure their dogs stay in the vehicle or are leashed until previous client leaves	Read all instructions
Pond Field Water Possibility of difficulty	1 mtr deepest point – slip entry for safe entry/exit – life ring provided	Read all instructions If concerned – use other field
Long Field Woodland area Possibility of scratching	Sticks, roots, holes to rummage	Checked daily for hazards
Dog faeces	Client must remove faeces before leaving field	Clearly instructed – park check 3 times daily
Unwanted interaction	The site is designed to minimise such and providing instructions are followed as agreed on booking then there is no possibility of such	Clear instructions prior to and throughout visit
Slips, trips, falls	Outdoors, field/agricultural area	Client must take care as in all outdoor activity
weather	Generally, this should not affect	Extreme conditions will result in temporary closure for safety
COVID19	As outdoor activity – providing distancing is adhered to – should not present issue	Distancing instructions at booking and Antibac provided on site with clean running water
noise	Outdoor area – controlled dogs	Persistent Anti social dogs will be removed
litter	No glassware / dog treats etc allowed to ensure nothing left behind as in booking terms	Litter bin provided
